**ASSEMBLYMEMBER SWANSON SCORES 100 PERCENT ON
PLANNED PARENTHOOD SCORECARD**

Assemblymember Sandré Swanson (D-Alameda) scored 100 percent on the 2009 Pro-Choice Scorecard issued by the Planned Parenthood Affiliates of California (PPAC).

PPAC advocates for a wide range of issues and usually scores votes on legislation affecting access to reproductive health care, including family planning services, sex education, and clinical services.

“The unprecedented difficulty in negotiating the budget last year made it very difficult for the Legislature to focus on policy bills. Nevertheless, the legislature managed to use good policy in their votes on the few bills that directly impacted PPAC,” said Assemblymember Swanson.
